Notes

Anyone who's been on a safari knows that no two game activities are ever the same! Guests traverse within the Bwabwata National Park, inside Africa's largest wildlife conservation area where around 295,000 elephants roam. It is a birder's paradise with 450 bird species. Activity times will vary depending on the season.

Please note of the following recommended items to bring, to make the most of your time in the bush:

- Binoculars and camera. Please take care when using a flash as it disturbs animals.
- Sunglasses, hat, sunblock, insect repellent.
- In winter, a sweater or fleece, especially for the evenings. We provide blankets and hot water bottles if it's cold, and there are also ponchos if it is raining.
- Pale and neutral coloured clothing when on the wild experiences so as not to attract the animals' attention.
- · Closed shoes for bush walks.
- We do provide basic fishing tackle, but you are welcome to bring along your own. Should you lose any of our tackle it will be charged additionally.
