
Our team, most of whom have been with us from the start, are trained to create deep connections that go beyond traditional safari travel, making every guest's journey truly life-changing.

With only 10 suites, beautifully paced and spaced, you'll feel as though there's nothing but you, the view, and the decadence within.






KAZILE ISLAND LODGE

Only accessible by boat, 13 Meru tents are surrounded by lush Mangosteen forest, immersing you in the sounds, scents and secrets of Mother Earth.




For those seeking slumber beneath the stars.




GAME DRIVES

Look out for the Big Four: lions, elephants, buffalo and leopards, as well as wild dogs and more. It's also a birder's paradise with 450 bird species to identify.


On foot, by boat or by vehicle.

A rare opportunity, as we're the only set of lodges permitted to offer guided walks within the park.




BOAT CRUISE

An informative, yet soulful experience on waterways similar to those of the Okavango Delta.




FISHING

Head out at dawn to fish for tilapia, catfish, nembwe, and the elusive tiger fish. We support catch-and-release fishing practices.




SUNDOWNERS

THE SIJWA PROJECT DREAM. CREATE. INSPIRE.

Launched in 2018, The Sijwa Project is a bold venture in sustainable development. One of the main goals of this initiative is to transform recyclable waste (including glass, plastic, carton, tin cans) from our lodges into unique, saleable crafts. But it's so much more than this.

It also includes organic permaculture greenhouses, sewing centres, a carpentry workshop, a vocational residency training centre, a beehive project to reduce human-elephant conflict, and an indigenous tree nursery.

Through this initiative, we help to transform lives. We empower the local community with skills, jobs, and environmental preservation. The project aims to employ community members, some of whom support up to 12 others in their village, so the impact is far-reaching.

A visit to The Sijwa Project leaves guests feeling enriched by local culture as they take part in and enjoy the activities, but also feel a sense of giving back. This is travel with purpose.


OFF THE BEATEN PATH,

- Find us in Namibia's untapped Zambezi region; that lush little panhandle just above Botswana.
- Easily accessible via the following airports: Vic Falls (Zimbabwe), Livingstone (Zambia), Kasane (Botswana), Katima (Namibia).
- You'll need a 4×4 vehicle to reach us, but we can arrange road transfers from these airports.
- If driving from Windhoek, we recommend stopping overnight at Rundu (440 km from us) or Bagani on the Okavango River (200 km from us).

- Immelman Landing Strip (no floats)
- Coordinates S 17° 46′500" E 023° 18′ 300"
- Length of runway: 1 300 m
